

## Bibliography of David French (1933–2017)

---

**Summary:** David French, director of the British Institute at Ankara from 1968 to 1994, was one of the foremost field archaeologists of his generation and published extensively. Most of the publications in this bibliography, which has been compiled by Stephanie Aulsebrook, Lisa French and Stephen Mitchell, fall into one of the following categories:

- Survey reports relating to prehistoric Greece and Anatolia, especially concerning pottery classification.
- Interim and final reports of the excavation projects that he directed in Turkey, the research excavations of the 1960s at Can Hasan I and Can Hasan III in south central Anatolia, and the rescue projects in 1970s and 1980s in the Euphrates region, at Asvan and at Tille Höyük.
- Preliminary studies and the final volumes, arranged by the Roman provinces, of Roman roads and milestones in Asia Minor, the project that dominated the second half of his professional life.
- Publication of other Greek and Latin inscriptions, an interest which developed in parallel with his work on roads and milestones.
